## **2024 Network Updates**

Beginning in 2024, across all lines of St. Luke's Health Plan business, covered services provided within the First Choice Health (FCH) and First Health (FH) networks will be covered at the innetwork benefit level—the same as care provided within the St. Luke's Health Partners Network. As long as services rendered are covered services, meaning they do not require a prior authorization, members have access to FCH/FH providers in 2024 as in-network.


Members can seek covered services from any provider they choose. To receive the highest level of medical benefit coverage, members must receive care from an in-network or wrap network provider.

Members can scan the QR code on their 2024 ID card or go to the Find a Doctor tool on the Health Plan website.

Coverage Area: When receiving care within the 20 counties, members will utilize St. Luke's Health Partners. When traveling or receiving care (emergent and non-emergent care) out of the 20-county service area, FCH and FH will be at the in-network benefit level.

Out-of-Network Care: In the event that a service is not available in network, St. Luke's Health Plan will review requests submitted through our waiver process to determine if approved at in-network benefit level.
